- As all official ANU correspondence will be sent to my ANU email address, I will regularly monitor the ANU email account that I have been provided with at the time of receipt of my offer of admission.
- Make contact with the ANU Access and Inclusion Office as requested.
- Advise the University of a change in contact details, including mobile phone number and address, within 7 days of the change occurring.
- Not transfer between University accommodation providers without prior written consent of my parent/legal guardian and the Registrar, Student Administration and Academic Services.
- Not stay away overnight from the approved University accommodation without prior written consent of my parent/legal guardian and the Registrar, Student Administration and Academic Services.
- Obtain written permission from my parent/legal guardian and the Registrar, Student Administration and Academic Services
- If I wish to undertake any travel outside of Canberra, including day trips or travel home while I am under 18.
- Act responsibly, comply with Australian Law by not participating in illicit activities, and not partake in any risk taking behaviour.

I give permission for the University to contact my parent/legal guardian, or staff of the Residential Hall to discuss matters regarding my welfare if the University reasonably believes this to be necessary at any time while I am under 18.

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Parent Declaration

The form is to be completed and signed by the parent/legal guardian of the student under the age of 18 intending to apply for a student visa to undertake studies at the Australian National University (ANU). The Department of Home Affairs requires that the University approves the living arrangements of students who:

- are under the age of 18;
- are accepting an offer to study at the University; and
- where the University is accepting responsibility for my child's welfare (Option 3 or 4), that my child will comply with the conditions listed in this agreement until his/her 18th birthday. In the event that my child does not comply with these conditions, I accept responsibility for transportation costs for my child to return home.

I acknowledge and agree that if my child is residing in a homestay arrangement through Australian Homestay Network (option 4) that my child is also registered with an ANU approved guardian service and that we are responsible for all associated costs payable.

I acknowledge and agree that if my child is residing in an ANU Hall of Residence (option 3) that my child will be registered with an ANU approved guardian service and that we are responsible for all associated costs payable.

I acknowledge that where Option 1 or 2 is chosen, that the University will not be accepting responsibility for my child's welfare. Department of Home Affairs will approve the welfare and accommodation arrangements and the University is not required to issue a Confirmation of Appropriate Accommodation and Welfare (CAAW) letter with the ECoE.

I give permission for a University internet access account to be created for my child and acknowledge that my child will have unrestricted access to the internet through facilities and services offered by the University.
